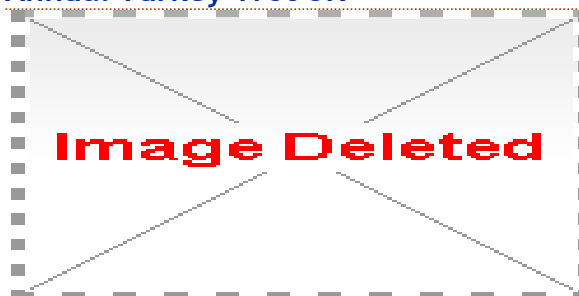
## Join us for a Lunchtime Tutt Talk on the Prime Dollhouse Collection
